THE HISTORY OF MCC – PART 1 (the beginning)

#### MARCH 1981-2021

It's hard to believe that Medina Community Church is celebrating 40 years as a church this month. When Weymouth Community Church was needing to do something with all their growth in the late 70's and early 80's they decided a church plant would be a good idea. They could no longer grow because of the facility restraints. So Pastor Wolf asked Pastor John VanEpp (wife Shirley) to take a small number of families from Weymouth to start a church in Medina. For the first few years they met at the High School, but this was difficult with all the set up and tear down for the Sunday service. Eventually they began to look for land to build or find something they could buy and remodel.

In 1984 the old Ohio Edison line shop was up for sale. At the time interest rates were over 10% and churches were not a good risk. Miraculously, the Bennet estate agreed to finance the purchase! Soon the congregation was meeting in the warehouse. With a lot of hard work, demolition of the loading dock and the transition from garage doors to windows, the building began to take shape. Soon it was a fully functioning church, with ministries for all ages and the church grew. Early on the value of faith and trusting God for the church's finances was embedded in the DNA of the church. God was faithful! He provided in ways that seemed impossible. It wasn't long before they found one of their first gifts from the Lord – free red carpet from the local car show! God is good and He is a faithful provider for our needs.
