From 1990 to 2000 MCC experienced some growing pains. On the positive side we were able to finish the new 2,000 square foot Christian Education addition on the north side of the building. The new construction gave the warehouse needed classroom space for both children and adult classes. We also added to our staff with the addition of Steve (Rosi) Sept who came to lead our children and youth areas. Steve started the first Amore' Night fundraiser and began the trips to Camp Ray Bird with our teens. Starting Line was our after school children's outreach which began in the 90's.

The 90's also brought a very painful experiences with a church split that broke up some really good friendships. It was hard seeing friends leave the church. As a pastor I remember feeling like there was nothing I could do to keep the church united. So we prayed and continued to seek the Lord as the dust settled from all the brokenness. I can say today looking back on that experience, we are no longer just a Bible church. Through that split came a renewed commitment to be a church that will love the lost. The balance of discipleship and evangelism is central to our core values today.

The rest of the 90's was a time of change—two services, a more contemporary style of worship, and lots of church potlucks. Over the years we saw many come to Christ and we celebrated their baptism at Pier-Lon Campground in August. So good keeping this tradition over the years. We can't wait to get back at it after a one year break because of Covid.
