Jesus - Been There! by Pastor Doug

Have you ever felt as though nobody understands what you were going through? You are a teenager who is struggling with feelings of anxiety. Or an adult that looks at the challenges of life and you wonder, "God, do you understand and care about what I am going through?"

Throughout our current series we have been looking at diverse ways Jesus did life, so we have a model for how to navigate life in a Godly way. Our key passage for the series is Hebrews 4:15 where it states, "we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with out weaknesses, but was tempted as we are, yet without sin." So, what that tells you and me is that when Jesus came to Earth, when he took on flesh, when he became fully human, he came here to redeem us from our sins. But he also came here to experience the full gamut of human experience. He knew what it was like to grieve the loss of a friend when Lazarus passed away. And he wept bitterly. He knew what it was like to be disappointed by his disciples who seemed to fail and never understand it every step of the way. He knew what it was like to be exhausted and tired when people came to him for miracle after miracle, and he just wanted to get away for some alone time. And he knew what it was like to be betrayed and abandoned by his friends when they all disappeared when he was arrested in the garden Gethsemane.

Jesus fully understands what you are going through. That is one of the great gifts that he gave us when he became human. And so, he stands between us and God as our high priest. We never have to worry about whether God gets us. He understands our humanity and he will show us the best kind of life to live. (John 10:10)


