The Purpose of the Church – By Pastor Doug

Every church needs to grow warmer through fellowship, deeper through discipleship, stronger through worship, broader through ministry, and larger through evangelism.

These five purposes of the church are commanded by Jesus in the Great Commandment and Great Commission, explained by Paul in Ephesians 4, described in Jesus' prayer for the church in John 17, and modeled by the first church in Jerusalem.

In Acts 2:42-47 these five facets of health are mentioned: They fellow-shipped, edified each other, worshipped, ministered, and evangelized. As a result, verse 47 says, "And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved."

The Five Dimensions of a Healthy Church

Churches grow warmer through fellowship. Churches grow deeper through discipleship. Churches grow stronger through worship. Churches grow broader through ministry. Churches grow larger through evangelism.

Church growth is the natural result of church health. When God's Word is taught, we will hopefully see all five of these areas growing and developing. Each of the five New Testament purposes of the church must be in equilibrium with the others for health to occur.

Now this is important: Because we are imperfect beings, balance in a church does not occur naturally!

In fact, we must continually correct imbalance. It is human nature to overemphasize the purpose of the church we feel most passionate about.

As a result, most evangelical churches already do the five purposes of the church – sort of

But they do not do them all equally well. One church may be strong in fellowship, yet weak in evangelism. Another may be strong in worship, yet weak in discipleship. Still another may be strong in evangelism, yet weak in ministry.

As we continue to move down a path of transitioning as a church from my pastorate to our next pastor, it is important to look at areas of strength while improving our weaker areas. I am praying for the church that we become even healthier spiritually as we step out in faith looking for the next shepherd to lead us. My prayer is that all five purposes will be even stronger in the days ahead.


African Children's Choir June 28
